Sikkim Government Sanskrit College, Samdong, was established in 1997 at Gyalshing, West Sikkim. Since its inception, the college has been affiliated with Sampurnananda Sanskrit University, Uttar Pradesh.

In 2010, the college was shifted to Samdong, East Sikkim, where it now resides on a permanent campus spanning 9.16 acres. The college offers BA Shastri course for students pursuing higher education in Sanskrit, with subjects including Sanskrit Grammar, Sanskrit Sahitya, Puran Itihas, Jyotish, along with Hindi, Nepali, and English.

The college serves students from across Sikkim, neighbouring North-Eastern states, and countries such as Bhutan and Nepal.

Currently, the college is in a transition phase between affiliations: the 2nd semester is conducted under Khangchendzonga State University, Sikkim, while the 4th and 6th semesters remain under Sampurnananda Sanskrit University, UP. This phased transition aligns with the New Education Policy and aims to eventually bring full affiliation to Khangchendzonga State University, expanding course offerings and academic opportunities.

Eligibility Criteria and Fee Structure

Eligibility Criteria

Admission to the Three-Year Shastri Program is open to students who meet the following conditions:

- Must have successfully passed Class 12 from a recognized education board.
- Preference is given to those who have studied Sanskrit at the school level or passed Class 12 with any subject in the Humanities stream.
- We provide bridge courses for students from non-Sanskrit backgrounds.

We especially encourage students from Sanskrit schools and those passionate about pursuing Sanskrit studies to apply.

Fee Structure

In keeping with the State Government's commitment to educational welfare, tuition fees are fully waived up to the college level, ensuring that quality Sanskrit education is accessible to all eligible students without financial barriers.

Students may only be responsible for minimal charges, such as university registration fees, examination fees, or optional extracurricular activity fees, in accordance with university regulations.
